He Is the Light // Revelation 21:22-22:5

Key Verse: Revelation 21:23 – “The city has no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and its lamp is the Lamb.”

Big Idea: Jesus is the Light who redeems our past with grace, anchors our present with His presence, and illuminates our future with everlasting glory!

Foundations

As one year ends and another begins, Revelation paints a stunning picture of eternity: a city so radiant that no sun or moon is required because God Himself is its light.

Jesus is the lamp that shines forever! This vision reminds us that the light we celebrate at Christmas is not temporary; it is eternal.

In a world shadowed by fear and uncertainty, Christ's light never fades. His presence doesn't just guide us; it transforms us. Living in His light today prepares us for the day when His glory will fill all things and we will see His face!

Understanding God's Word

1. Why does John highlight that the city needs no sun or moon? What does this reveal about God's glory?
2. How does the image of Jesus as both Lamb and lamp deepen your understanding of His role in redemption?
3. How does this passage connect to Jesus' words in John 8:12: “I am the light of the world”?

Applying God's Word

1. How does knowing that His light covers your past free you from guilt or regret?
2. In what ways can His light guide your choices and attitudes today?
3. How does the promise of eternal light in Revelation 21:23 give you hope for what lies ahead?

Witnessing God's Word

This week, ask God to show you one person who needs encouragement and hope. Pray for them and look for a way to reflect Christ's light—through a conversation, a note, or an act of kindness.
