- 1. Matthew 28: 16-20 The Great Commission the first gathering of the church was worship. What did that look like? Discussion of what it might look like. Were people doubting or how does that look? The primary command that Jesus makes is to make disciples. Make disciples by going, baptizing and teaching. When you are baptized you are identified with Christ, entry into the church, reaching people who are lost and seeing them give themselves to Christ. The disciples are to be teaching to obey. It isn't just what do you know but what you will submit to in knowing Jesus. "You" is not a singular You but a plural word. And they move out in the authority of Christ.

PART TWO: POLICY AND GOVERNANCE MOMENT

- **1.** Church Governance Models
 - **a.** Episcopal Hierarchical Form. Authority flows from top down.
 - b. Congregational Emphasizes the autonomy of the local church. Congregational voting model – bottom up.
 - c. Presbyterian Leadership through elected elders. Authority is made collectively through council of elders both bottom up (elections) and from top down (higher governing bodies).
 - d. What the congregation has responsibility to do Electing Elders, Deacons, trustees, pastor/associating, nominating committee, calling of pastor to serve or dissolve call, buying mortgaging, transfer or selling property, dismissing the congregation from one presbytery to another within ECO,



approving amendments to governing documents, authorizing assisting pastors to be part of session with voice and vote.

What the session has responsibility for keeping the church accountable for the mission, sacraments are rightly administered, ensure we have a disciple making ministry, elect commissioner to presbytery meetings, role of covenant partners, adopts the annual budget, financial review and published to the congregation, evaluate the congregation's mission and ministry to the presbytery.
